At the Leipzig Fair in autumn 1937, TRIX presented a new collection of scale table top model trains. Only two and a half years after the start of TRIX EXPRESS, the four-wheel toy locos had developed into scale 4-6-2 precision Pacific locomotives, along with scale coaches and trucks.

TRIX made the very first table top Pacific locomotive. This is the reason for the next great historic model railway show in Berlin, similar to the anniversary exhibitions of the last years.

This exhibition will include more than 30 historic steps of model train evolution – layouts and show cases. We will have interesting layouts from German and international exhibitors. Some special items are announced!

John Hopkinson will offer his well known repaintings. The program is completed by evening events: Pizza and Drinks among the layouts on Friday and a Bavarian Inn with proper meals and Okoberfest Beer on Saturday.

British TRIX enthusiasts are invited to Berlin and to be part of the show with their own layout. The Berlin TRIX friends will help by supplying tables, bakelite track, AC & DC power supplies and other basic requirements. Like the similar Berlin meetings in the last years we will support UK guests with help and advice so that they have a good time.
